In 1986, buildings on the shores of Town Lake were allowed a maximum height of 96 feet or 8 stories. In 1999, height limits were omitted from the code and now buildings can be as high as 200 feet or 17 - 20 stories along some areas of the lake front.

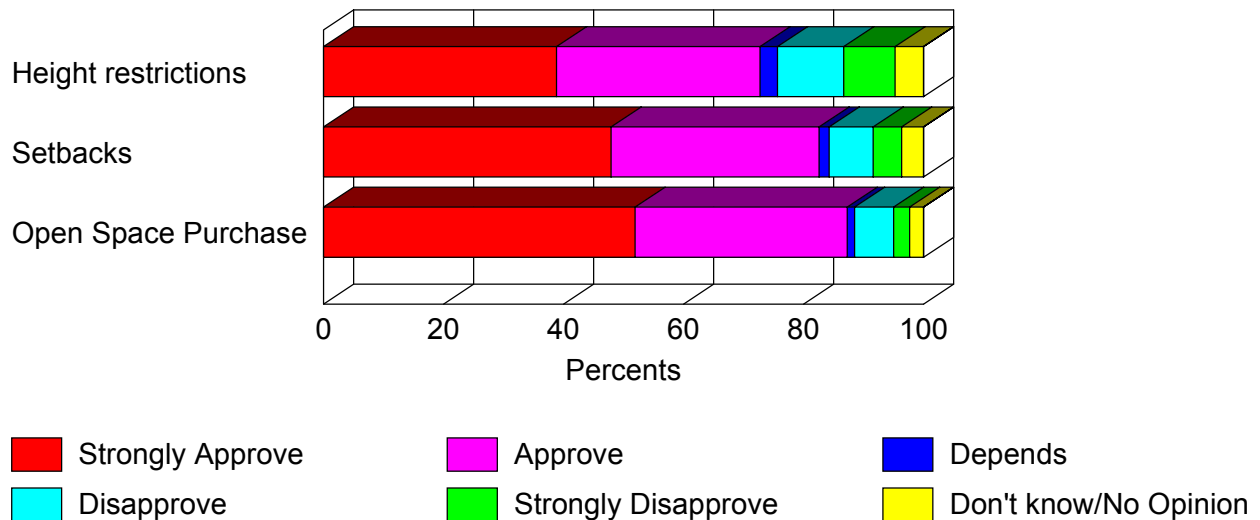
